

PRIVACY POLICY

I. General statements

This Privacy Policy sets out the principles for the processing and protection of personal data for users of the www.fundacjaworld.pl website, of which Fundacja World is the Administrator. The Foundation cares about privacy and ensures a high standard of protection for the personal data of Service Users. Privacy Policy contains information on how the personal data of the Users shall be processed by the Foundation.

II. Terms used:

Foundation: the World Foundation with its registered office at st. Ojca Maksymiliana Kolbe 66/10, 64-920 Piła

Website: the website with all its features located at address: www.fundacjaworld.pl

User: the person using the Website

Policy: this privacy policy

RODO: Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC

III. Personal Data of the User

As a result of using the Website, the Foundation may process the following personal data: first and last name, financial information (e.g. account or credit card number), contact information contact information (e-mail address, telephone), identity document number, address of residence.

The administrator of the personal data of the Service Users is the Foundation.

In all matters related to the protection of personal data, you can contact:

The User's providing of data is voluntary, but may be necessary in order to use of the Website's functions.

III. Legal basis and purpose of data processing

IV.

The Foundation processes the personal data of Service Users for the following purposes:

(a) to enable Users to make donations to the Foundation:

The Foundation processes personal data of Users who make donations to the Foundation through the Website. The legal basis for the processing is Article 6(1)(b) of the RODO (implementation of the donation agreement in favour of the Foundation).

(b) To enable the submission of an enquiry to obtain support from the Foundation:

Users have the possibility to send an enquiry via a form available on the Website. The legal basis for the processing is Article 6(1)(f) RODO (pursuit of a legitimate interest of the Foundation, i.e. statutory purposes) and Article 9(2)(d) of the RODO, in the case of the transfer of special category data (processing in the legitimate activities of the Foundation carried out with appropriate security features)

(c) ensuring the security and functionality of the Service: The Foundation processes personal data in order to analyse the correct operation of the Website, to obtain statistics on the traffic on the Site and for archiving purposes. The Foundation also handles complaints Users related to problems with the operation of the Service. The legal basis processing is Article 6(1)(f) of the RODO (fulfilment of the Foundation's legitimate interests, i.e. ensuring the operation of the Service).

(d) Investigation or protection against possible claims:

In the event of possible claims against Users or the need to protection against claims, the Foundation may process User data obtained via the Website. The legal basis for the processing is Article 6(1)(f) RODO (fulfilment of the Foundation's legitimate interest i.e. protection against claims or enforcement of claims).

V. Recipients of data

Recipients of personal data of the Service Users may be employees and associates of the Foundation who have been appropriately authorised to process personal data of the Users. In case the Foundation uses subcontractors providing services related to the operation of the Service or the Foundation (e.g. technical support), the recipients of the data may also be subcontractors, in particular telecommunication operators and Internet payment operators. In that case, the Foundation will enter into appropriate agreements with them. The Foundation may be obliged to make personal data available at the request of public authorities entitled to do so on the basis of relevant appropriate laws.

VI. Data processing duration

The Foundation retains the personal data of Users who have provided financial support for 6 years from the end of the year in which the support was provided. Data relating to requests for support are processed until contacted by a by a member of the Foundation's staff, in any case for no longer than two years from the date the request was sent.

VII. Users' rights in relation to data processing

In relation to the processing of personal data, the User has the right to:

(a) access to the data (the Foundation is obliged to provide the User with any information about the manner and scope of the User's personal data being processed);

b) to correct the data (if the User considers the data to be inaccurate or incomplete, the User may request that the Foundation to correct the data);

c) erasure of data (the User is entitled to request the erasure of his/her personal data and the Foundation is obliged to comply with the request if it is legally justified);

d) restriction of the processing of personal data (the User is entitled to request the restriction of the processing of his/her personal data in the cases specified);

e) transfer of personal data (the User is entitled to request the

Foundation to transfer the personal data in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format, only if the processing has taken place on the basis of a contract or consent and has taken place automated manner);

f) to object to the processing (the User may object against the processing of his/her personal data on the basis of a legitimate interest or for statistical purposes (because of his or her particular situation) or to the processing of data for direct marketing purposes).

In the event of a violation of data protection legislation, the User has the right to file a complaint with the President of the Data Protection Authority.

VIII. Data processing outside the EEA

The Foundation does not transfer Users' personal data to countries outside the European Economic Area.
